Ensuring ease of access within the buildings

Wheelchairs are available for use in all of our surgeries.

Patients may use their electric mobility scooters within all our buildings.

All our surgeries have;

- Automatic doors
- Open spaces that will allow wheelchairs to turn
- · Chairs with arms
- Wider chairs

Patients are welcome to ask for help if they feel that they need it

Transport – buses

To Rosebery Medical Centre

The Arriva 127, get off at Radmoor Road and walk along Storer Road.

The Arriva 127, get off at Loughborough Hospital and walk along Hospital Way.

Kinch no 5 - get off at Alan Moss Road and walk along Hospital Way.

The Sprint - get off at Radmoor Road and walk along Storer Road.

To Forest Edge Medical Centre

The Arriva 127– get off at Windleden Road. Kinch no 5 - get off at Windleden Road.

To Outwoods Medical Centre

The Kinch no 12 (clockwise out of town) or Kinch 11 anti clockwise, towards town. Get off at Beaumont Road.

Transport - Taxis

ABC Ace taxis - Tel 01509 218585. 07.00-01.00. They cannot take roll—on wheelchairs but will assist wheel chair passengers and carry the folded chair in the boot

ADT taxis-Tel 01509 260000, 24 hours service, is willing to offer a discount to our patients, depending on the length of the journey. They cannot take roll-on wheelchairs but will assist wheel chair passengers and carry the folded chair in the boot

Collins Taxis - 01509 211647. They are willing to help people with mobility problems, but the passenger needs to be able to climb up to a high seat.

Loughborough Taxis - 01509 212111. They are happy to assist a wheel chair user in and out of the car. They will carry the chair folded down in the boot.

Epinal Taxis – 01509 235588. They are happy to assist a wheelchair user in and out of the car. They will carry the chair folded down in the boot.

Transport - Other
